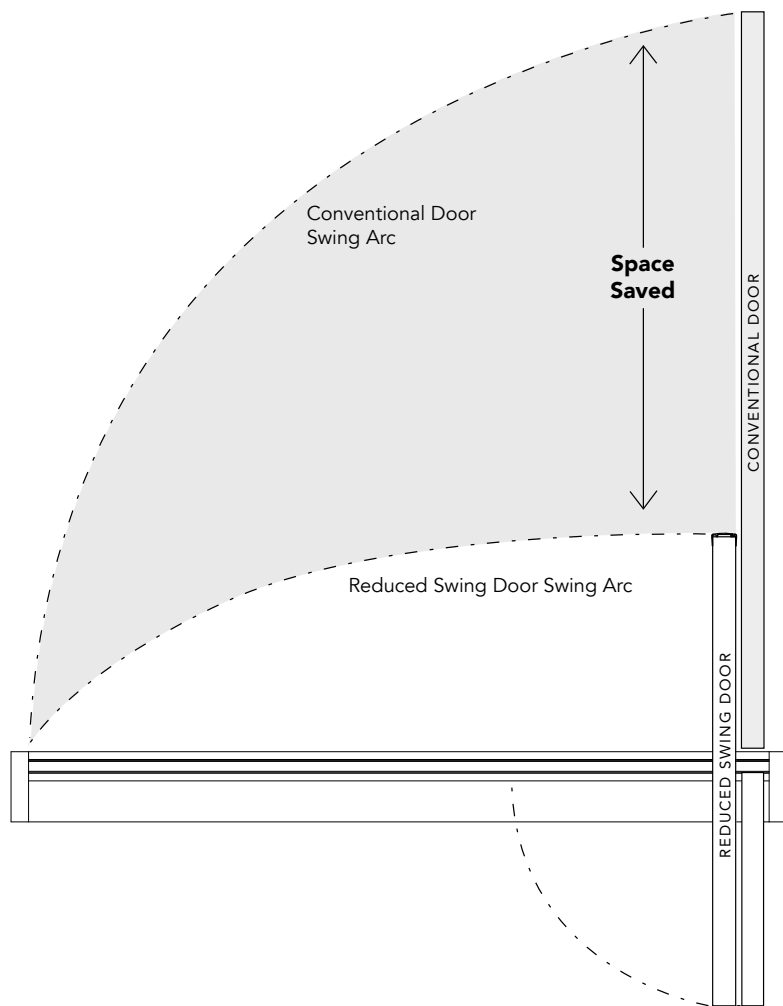

Hallmark Reduced Swing Double Action Doorset

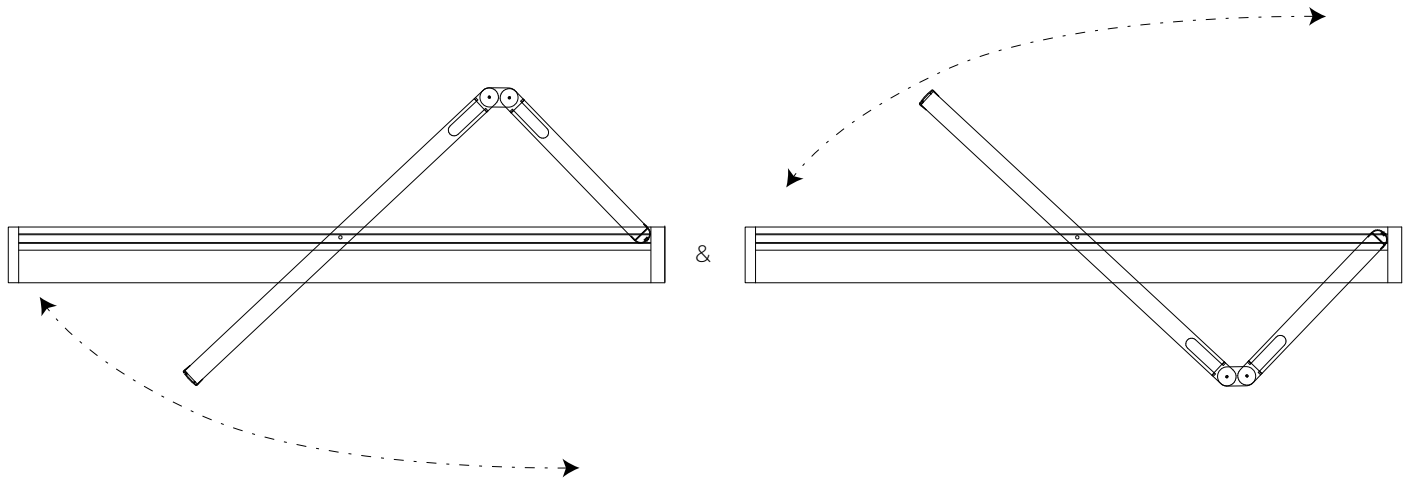
Description:

The Hallmark Reduced Swing Door (also known as a Reduced Swing Bi-fold Door) has a reduced swing arc, making it ideal for wheelchairs or where patients have limited mobility such as those using a walking frame, as well as space-saving in efficient designed builds.

The door concertinas in on itself, reducing the swing arc by a third of that of a standard door.

Two panel articulated door

Door swing follows an elliptical curve, reducing door swing by one-third of conventional doors

Fits a standard door frame

Wall space is not compromised. Reduced door swing uses less floor space - perfect for constrained space

NON-TRAP OPERATING GEAR DESIGN

Unlike other reduced swing door options available in the NZ market, the Hallmark design includes a non-trap operating gear, meaning no large gaps are created by the door pivot, significantly reducing trap-risk.

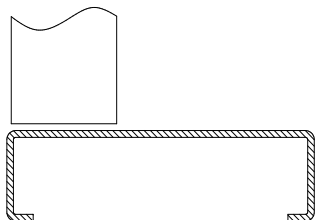
